## The Chrismon Christmas Tree

The Chrismon Christmas Tree, which originated in the Lutheran Church of the Ascension in Danville, Virginia, in 1957, serves as a tribute to Christ.



"Chrismon" is a blend of two words: CHRIST and MONogram, representing a monogram of Christ.



The creator of the Chrismon Tree conducted extensive research and discovered these monograms in various places—within the Bible, on utensils, in jewelry, catacombs, and buildings. Early Christians used these symbols to identify one another, mark church meeting locations, and witness to non-believers. More importantly, these symbols were a means of sharing their faith. Over time, additional symbols representing the Savior have been incorporated into the Chrismons.

Many Chrismons feature combinations of two or more symbols. The colors used are strictly white and gold, which are the liturgical colors for Christmas. White symbolizes the purity and perfection of our Savior, while gold reflects the glory and majesty of God and His Son.


