BISHOP ROBIN DEASE WILL VISIT ST. JAMES FEBRUARY 15

On February 15, we will be blessed by a visit from the Bishop of the Georgia Episcopal Area of The United Methodist Church, Bishop Robin Dease! She will share the word at our 11:00 service about the importance of community in the life of the United Methodist Church. Bishop Dease will also lead a combined Sunday School lesson that morning at 9:45 in the Fellowship Hall.

Bishop Dease grew up in Brooklyn, New York, one of 13 siblings. She graduated from Claflin University in Orangeburg, South Carolina in 1992. She earned a Master of Divinity degree and a Doctor of Ministry degree in stewardship from Wesley Theological Seminary in Washington, D.C.

Before her election to the episcopacy, Bishop Dease served as pastor and district superintendent in the South Carolina Conference of The United Methodist Church and has been involved in numerous denominational and conference boards and committees.
